How to Use:

Potting On Plants:

Re-potting is best done in the spring, when plants are actively growing. Before re-potting, water plants well and allow to drain.

Put fresh compost in the bottom of a new pot.

Turn the old plant upside down and tap pot sharply to release.

Place the plant in the middle of the new pot and add more compost, firming lightly around the rootball.

Leave a space of at least 1cm below the pot rim to allow adequate space for watering. Water the plant well.

Growing On:

This Levington John Innes No. 3. compost provides all of the necessary food for up to 6 weeks. After that time, water with Miracle-Gro Water Soluble Plant Food.



Storage:

Keep Levington John Innes Compost away from pesticides, particularly lawn weed killers or fertiliser containing lawn weed killers. Use the compost within a year. Keep the compost bag closed when not being used to stop it drying out. Storing from one year to another may result in the fertiliser ratios becoming unbalanced.
