Care of Orchids:

After re-potting place the orchid in a shaded spot that is constantly humid. Most orchids appreciate natural light, but not direct sunlight.

WATERING: Keep the compost moist, but not too wet using clean, tepid rainwater.

FEEDING: Start feeding after 4 weeks using a high potash plant food such as **Levington® Tomorite®** at half the recommended strength. Feed every 3 weeks during the growing season and stop feeding completely during the Winter.



The needs of different orchids vary significantly. Consult specialist publications or go to our website www.lovethegarden.com to make sure you are giving your plant the correct care.

How to Use:

Use the compost directly from the bag. Do not mix with other materials. Firm only lightly.

Re-potting:

After 2 or 3 years most orchids will have filled their pot and will need re-potting.

1. Remove the plant from its existing pot.
2. Divide the plant if appropriate.
3. Remove any dead roots.
4. Select a new pot that is one size larger (or smaller containers for each division) and cover the base of the pot with broken crocks or gravel.
5. Add a layer of Levington® Orchid Compost.
6. Place the orchid in the pot so the crown is just below the rim.
7. Place more compost between and around the roots, tapping the pot to settle the compost.
8. Water thoroughly with clean, tepid rainwater. Support with a cane if necessary.
