HOW TO USE:

Equipment: Use either a watering can, fitted with a Weedkiller
Sprinkle Bar or fine rose, or a sprayer.
Clean equipment thoroughly before and after use.
Do not use in galvanised or mild steel watering cans or sprayers.

Amount to apply

The amount of Tumbleweed required depends on the type of
weeds to be treated.

Mixing and Applying

Using the measure supplied, add the required dose to the
water and mix thoroughly. Apply the spray evenly to the
weeds, to lightly wet the leaves. Allow the spray to dry before
walking or playing on treated areas.

Type of weed	Amount of Tumbleweed added to: Sprayer: 1 litre water Watering can: 5 litres water	Area treated	Examples
Annual weeds	20ml	20 sq m	Annual Meadow-grass, Chickweed, Speedwells, Bindweed, Cleavers
Perennial weeds	30ml	20 sq m	Creeping Thistle, Perennial Nettle, Docks
Tough perennial weeds	40ml	20 sq m	Bramble, Bracken, Couch Grass, Ground Elder

Tumbleweed starts to attack the weed immediately with
results visible after 2-4 weeks.

Problem weeds may require repeat treatment if new
growth appears.

CAUTION: Tumbleweed kills all green plant growth including
lawn grasses.

DO NOT apply to lawns and plants if you want to keep them.
Avoid all contact by spray and spray drift with cultivated plants
and desired vegetation.

Keep children and pets away from treated areas until dry.

TIPS: PLANTING AND SOWING

- Where a light covering of annual weeds has been treated
plant / sow one day after spraying
- Where a dense covering of annual and / or perennial weeds
has been treated plant / sow 7 days after spraying.

of application.

- Gravel areas, paths and drives
 - Around sheds and greenhouses
 - Along fences
 - Ground clearance before autumn or spring digging
 - Killing old lawns before re-seeding or turfing
- Tumbleweed can be applied right up to the edge of cultivated
areas and lawns.
