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HOW TO USE

Scotts® Osmocote® Native Potting Mix is a complete, premium mix that requires nothing more for up to 9 months – just add water.

- 1 Select a clean pot at least 25mm wider than the original and partly fill it with potting mix.
- 2 Gently remove the plant from its container, loosen the root ball, and trim away any rotten or completely dried out roots.
- 3 Position the plant in the middle of the pot and fill around it with potting mix, just up to the base of the stem. Do not pack down.
- 4 Water evenly to wet all the mix and help it settle, then protect the plant from wind, heat, and strong sunlight for a week to allow it to adjust to its new home.



ONGOING PLANT CARE

- **Plants should be watered** immediately after potting and then frequently enough to meet the requirements of the plant variety.
- **To check if your plant needs water**, gently push your finger 2-3 cm into the mix and if it feels dry, it's time to water. If it feels slightly moist, test again in the following days.
- **Plants should be re-potted** with fresh Scotts Osmocote Native Potting Mix when they outgrow the pot or after 2-3 years.



SAFETY TIPS



We recommend you always wear gloves when gardening. Wear a particulate mask if dusty. Keep the product moist while handling. Wash hands immediately after use.

HAZARDOUS

This product is made from organic materials, including composted pinebark, and contains living micro-organisms, including bacteria, fungi and protozoa. Also contains mineral and fertiliser additives.

RISK
