HOW TO USE

Scotts® Osmocote® The Best Potting Mix is a complete, superior mix that requires nothing more for up to 12 months – just add water.

- 1 Select a clean pot at least 25mm wider than the original and partly fill it with potting mix.
- 2 Gently remove the plant from its container, loosen the root ball, and trim away any rotten or completely dried out roots.
- 3 Position the plant in the middle of the pot and fill around it with potting mix, just up to the base of the stem. Do not pack down.
- 4 Water evenly to wet all the mix and help it settle, then protect the plant from wind, heat, and strong sunlight for a week to allow it to adjust to its new home.

ONGOING PLANT CARE

- **Water plants frequently** to ensure the mix remains moist but not saturated. Avoid allowing plants to dry out.
- **To check if your plant needs water**, gently push your finger 2-3 cm into the soil and if it feels dry, it's time to water. If it feels slightly moist, test again in the following days.
- After a year, **additional plant food** may be required – we recommend Scotts® Osmocote® Controlled Release Fertiliser.
- **Plants should be re-potted** with fresh Scotts® Osmocote® The Best Potting Mix when they outgrow the pot or after 2-3 years.

SAFETY TIPS



We recommend you always wear gloves when gardening. Wear a particulate mask if dusty. Wash hands immediately after use. Keep the product moist while handling.

HAZARDOUS

COMPOSTS, POTTING MIXES AND OTHER ORGANIC GARDENING MATERIALS
This product is made from organic materials, including composted pinebark, and contains living micro-organisms, including bacteria, fungi and protozoa. Also contains mineral and fertiliser additives.

RISK
Inhalation of dust and/or liquid mists may irritate, inflame or sensitise the nose, throat and lungs resulting in illnesses ranging from hayfever or asthma, to pneumonia (e.g. Legionnaire's disease) or pneumonia-like illnesses. SAFETY

FIRST AID
