HOW TO USE

Scotts® Organic* Seed Starter is ready to use straight from the bag with no further additives required.

SEED RAISING

Where possible, follow instructions supplied with seeds for best results.

- 1 Use a seed raising tray or punnet suited to the size of the seed.
- 2 Loosely fill with Seed Starter mix to the top of the container without compacting the mix.
- 3 As a rule of thumb, seeds should be planted twice as deep as their size. For smaller seeds, sprinkle over the top of the Seed Starter mix.
- 4 Add more Seed Starter to lightly cover seeds if required.
- 5 Water regularly to maintain moisture.

GARDEN BEDS & POTS

Transplanting to Garden Beds

Prepare garden bed with Scotts® Organic* Soil Improver to revitalise the soil and provide a strong foundation for happy, healthy plants.

Transplanting to Pots

Fill pot with Scotts® Organic* Potting Mix to grow strong, resilient plants.



SAFETY TIPS

HAZARDOUS

COMPOSTS, POTTING MIXES AND OTHER ORGANIC GARDENING MATERIALS

This product is made from organic materials, including composted pinebark, and contains living micro-organisms, including bacteria, fungi and protozoa. Also contains mineral and fertiliser additives.

RISK

Inhalation of dust and/or liquid mists may irritate, inflame or sensitise the nose, throat and lungs resulting in illnesses ranging from hayfever or asthma, to pneumonia (e.g. Legionnaire's disease) or pneumonia-like illnesses. Direct contact with this material or its dust and/or liquid mists (bioaerosols) may cause skin irritation (dermatitis), and skin or eye infection or irritation. SAFETY
