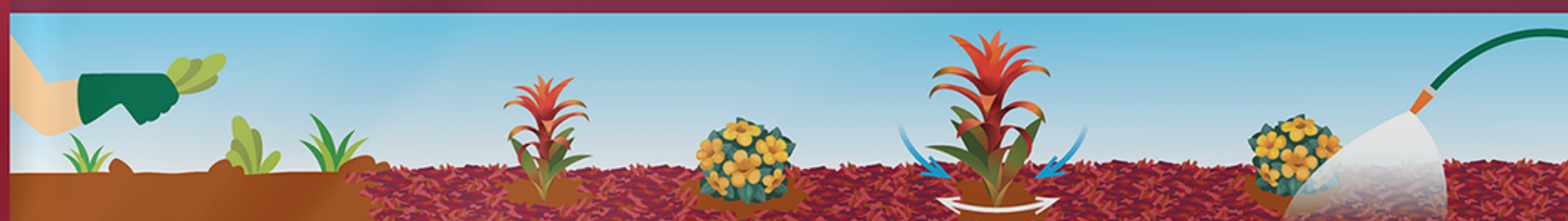

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HOW TO USE



- 1 PREPARE AREA**
Remove any weeds and debris before applying mulch.
- 2 APPLY MULCH**
Spread mulch evenly around plants to a depth of 2-5cm.
- 3 ALLOW CLEAR AREA**
Keep mulch 3-5cm clear from plant stems to allow airflow and prevent rot.
- 4 WATER IN WELL**
after applying to help mulch settle and mat together.

TIPS & ONGOING CARE

- For best results, apply mulch after planting.
- Top up mulch as required to maintain good coverage, soil health and moisture.
- Start strong with a mix that brings out the best in your plants, try Scotts® Osmocote The Best Potting Mix.



SAFETY TIPS



We recommend you always wear gloves when gardening. Wear a particulate mask if dusty. Keep the product moist while handling. Wash hands immediately after use.
