Osmocote® Professional Orchid Mix was specifically developed by horticultural experts to provide the ideal root environment for growing show quality orchids, including all Epiphytes and Terrestrial Orchids.

Engineered for ideal water to air ratio, this mix is formulated to contain balanced and slowly delivered nutrients, which are gentle on orchids.

- Contains Osmocote® controlled release plant food – feeds plants for up to 12 months.
- Formulated with coir chips and graded composted pine bark, which provides easy anchoring for roots and moisture retention.
- Professional grade wetting agent added to ensure uniform wetting mix and prevent drying out.
- Added Calcium to strengthen pseudo bulbs and flower stems, and encourage strong disease resistance.

This mix complies with the requirements of AS3743 for a premium grade potting mix

Easy to use instructions

We recommend wearing gardening gloves when using all planting materials.

Where to use

Osmocote® Professional Orchid Mix is suitable for Epiphytes including Phalaenopsis, Dendrobium and Cattleya, and Terrestrial Orchids including Cymbidium.

How to use



1. Use Osmocote® Professional Orchid Mix straight from the bag. For best results, do not mix with any other material. Close bag tightly after use.
2. Turn the plant out of its existing container. Loosen the root ball. If necessary separate into smaller clumps of 3 or 4 pseudo bulbs, and remove any damaged or dead roots.
3. Select a clean container with large drainage holes and partly fill the pot with Osmocote® Professional Orchid Mix.
4. Place the orchid in the pot so the crown is just below the rim.
5. Place more mix between and around the roots. Tap the new container gently to allow the mixture to settle. Do not pack down.
6. It is essential to water the plant after planting. Allow the excess water to drain away and place in the shade for 2-3 days to allow the plant to establish.

- Great soil is critical for spectacular plants. Osmocote® Professional Orchid Mix helps create an ideal growing environment to get orchids off to a great start.

...Feed it Right

- Most plants are hungry feeders. Begin a feeding program using Osmocote® controlled release plant food 12 months after planting. Always follow package instructions.
- If possible water plants early in the morning. Avoid late evening watering as this can increase plant disease. The frequency of watering will depend on the size of the plant and time of the year.
