- Professional grade granular wetting agent added to ensure uniform wetting and rewetting of mix.
- Enhanced levels of Calcium to promote strong flower stems and prevent bulb loss from disease.
- Boosted Magnesium for healthy dark green leaves.

Easy to use instructions

We recommend wearing gardening gloves when using all planting materials.

Where to use

Osmocote® Professional Bulb Mix is suitable for all bulbous plants including Daffodils, Tulips, Jonquils and Hyacinths.

How to use



- 1.** Use Osmocote® Professional Bulb Mix straight from the bag. For best results, do not mix with any other material. Close bag tightly after use.
- 2.** Select a clean container with large drainage holes and at least 15 cm deep to allow for good root growth. Partly fill the container with Osmocote® Professional Bulb Mix.
- 3.** Set the bulbs in place according to indicated planting depths and plant spacings. Fill in with Osmocote® Professional Bulb Mix to within 2-3cm from the top of the container.
- 4.** Water the pot well, drain and keep the container in a cool, shady place until leaves emerge. Then move the container into a well lit, sheltered position.
- 5.** Keep the soil moist at all times but do not over-water.

- Great soil is essential for producing spectacular plants. Osmocote® Professional Bulb Mix helps create an ideal growing environment for flowering bulbs.

...Feed it Right

- Most plants are hungry feeders. Begin a feeding program using Osmocote® controlled release plant food or Osmocote® Plus Organics plant food 6 months after planting. Always follow package instructions.
- Most bulbous plants will respond to feeds of liquid fertilizers when flower buds appear and after flowers have finished.
- If possible water early in the morning. Avoid late evening watering as this can increase plant disease.
- The frequency of watering will depend on the size of the plant and time of the year.
