- Low Phosphorus to prevent yellowing leaves and Phosphorus toxicity.
- Next Generation water crystals for moisture retention.
- Professional grade wetting agent added to ensure uniform wetting of mix and prevent drying out.
- Added Calcium for stronger plants and stems.
- Boosted levels of Iron for healthy dark green foliage, and to help prevent Phosphorus toxicity.

Easy to use instructions

We recommend wearing gardening gloves when using all planting materials.

Where to use

Osmocote® Professional Native Potting & Planting Mix is suitable for various Australian natives and all Proteas.

How to use



1. Use Osmocote® Professional Native Potting & Planting Mix straight from the bag. For best results, do not mix with any other material. Close bag tightly after use.
2. Before repotting, water the plants thoroughly and allow them to drain.
3. Select a clean container with large drainage holes and partly fill the pot with Osmocote® Professional Native Potting & Planting Mix.
4. Turn the plant out of its existing container. Gently tease the old mix from the outside of the root ball.
5. Position the plant in the centre of the new container, and fill with Osmocote® Professional Native Potting & Planting Mix to within 2cm from the top of the container.
6. Tap the new container gently to allow the mixture to settle. Do not pack down.
7. Water thoroughly and add more potting mix if settling occurs after watering. Allow the excess water to drain away and place in the shade for 2-3 days to allow the plant to establish.

...Feed it Right

- Most plants are hungry feeders. Begin a feeding program using Osmocote® Controlled Release Plant Food 6 months after planting. Always follow package instructions.
- If possible water plants early in the morning. Avoid late evening watering as this can increase plant disease. The frequency of watering will depend on the size of the plant and time of the year.
