HOW TO USE Avoid spraying outdoors under hot or windy conditions.
DO NOT apply to young seedlings.

Spray directly onto insects & surrounding foliage including the undersurfaces of leaves. Hold the bottle 25cm from the plants & apply in a sweeping motion. |
