

Horticultural Sand

Debco Horticultural Sand helps to distribute water evenly in potting and planting mixes preventing dry areas within the mix. Horticultural sand increases porosity by opening soils offering plenty of drainage and aeration for plants like cacti & succulents, orchids and propagated cuttings.

Horticultural Sand is sourced from mined sands to ensure it is pathogen & disease free. Use to add weight to potting mixes to prevent tall, top heavy plants from blowing or tipping over.

Debco Horticultural Sand is ideal in the following applications

- Seed raising mix
- Regular potting mix

Creates 10 Litres of Mix

Seed Raising Mix

- 8.5L Peat Moss (85%)
- 1.5L Horticultural Sand (15%)
- 250ml Vermiculite

Blend Peat Moss and Horticultural Sand to create a seed raising mix.

Sprinkle Vermiculite as a fine layer on top of the mix.

Regular Potting Mix

- 8L Regular potting mix (80%)
- 2L Horticultural Sand (20%)

Blend regular potting mix and Horticultural Sand to open the mix and distribute water, adding weight and preventing the pot from tipping over.
