Debco Cacti & Succulent Superior Potting Mix is ready to use straight from the bag with no further additives required.

- 1 Choose a pot at least 25% larger than the original with drainage holes.
- 2 Turn plant out of present container and carefully remove old loose mix from the root ball.
- 3 Position the plant and carefully fill the pot ensuring the potting mix surrounds all of the roots.
- 4 Water in thoroughly and allow draining and drying in a warm sunny position.

## ONGOING PLANT CARE

- A quality 6 month balanced fertiliser was added at manufacture but further fertilising is required. Use a Controlled Release Fertiliser suitable for cacti and succulents.
- Plants should be watered immediately after potting and frequently enough to ensure the mix remains moist but not wet. Avoid allowing plants to dry out.
- Plants should be re-potted with new potting mix when they outgrow the pot or after 12–18 months.
