Food & Nutrition

Controlled release fertiliser formulated for Natives promotes fast and continuous growth. Essential trace elements ensure strong healthy plants. The soluble nitrogen content of this mix is higher and its ability to consume soluble nitrogen is lower than that of regular mixes. A balanced fertiliser was added at the time of manufacture, but additional fertiliser may be required, depending on plant needs.

Water

SaturAid Granular Wetting Agent gets water directly to the root system.

Support

Made from quality composted Pine Bark. A long-lasting mix with good drainage and aeration for optimal plant establishment and development.

HOW TO USE

1 Use Debco Native Mix straight from the bag. For the best results do not mix with anything. Close the bag tightly after use.

2 Do as many plants as possible at one time, gathering them all together along with clean containers and the potting mix.

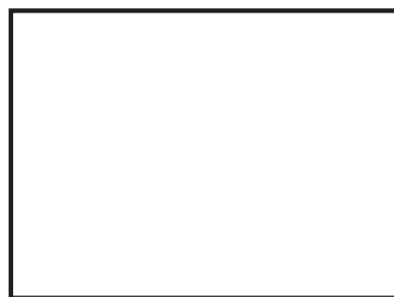


3 Give each plant a thorough watering an hour or so in advance, and allow to drain.



4 Select a clean container approximately 25mm wider than the original and partly fill with the mixture.

5 Turn the plant out of its present container. Loosen root ball gently and remove any rotten or entirely dried out roots.



6 Position the plants in the container and when happy with arrangement check levels and fill with new potting mix.

7 Shake the container gently by tapping the bottom on the ground to allow the mixture to settle. Do not firm or pack down. Normal watering will provide sufficient firming down of the potting mix.



8 Initial soaking after potting is essential and then a regular watering programme is important.

9 Protect plant from heat and strong sunlight for a few days and keep moist. Water only when the growing mixture feels dry.

In Ground Use Blend Native Mix with your garden soil and dig a hole for planting native plants.
