## "The Original Gro-Bag"

| CROP                         | PLANTS<br>PER BAG | START FEEDING WHEN                     |
|------------------------------|-------------------|--|
| Tomatoes – under glass       | 3                 | The fruit on first truss is pea sized  |
| Tomatoes – outdoor           | 3                 | The fruit on second truss is pea sized |
| Peppers & Aubergines         | 3                 | The fruit is the size of a golf ball   |
| Melons                       | 2                 | The first fruit is swelling            |
| Courgettes/Marrows/Cucumbers | 2                 | The first picking commences            |

## \_\_\_\_

Store in a cool dry place, away from sun, in a frost free position. Keep the bag closed when in storage to prevent drying out. Keep away from pesticides.

Storage from one year to another may affect performance.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY ADVICE:**

USE IN A WELL VENTILATED PLACE AND AVOID BREATHING IN DUST.
ALWAYS WEAR GLOVES WHEN GARDENING AND THEN WASH HANDS AFTER USE.
OPEN BAG CAREFULLY AND RESEAL AFTER USE.

Occasionally, a white mould may appear on the compost. This is not harmful to your plants and should disappear naturally.
