

The following Levington John Innes composts are available:

Levington John Innes No. 1. for seedlings, young plants, cuttings and plug plants.

Levington John Innes No. 2. for general repotting.

Levington John Innes No. 3. for final repotting of mature plants.

Levington John Innes Seed, for seed sowing and rooting cuttings.

Levington John Innes Ericaceous, for lime hating plants such as Azalias, Heathers and Rhodedendrons.

John Innes composts were developed in the 1930s. They are based on a traditional mixture of loam, peat and washed and graded horticultural grit.



Levington John Innes No. 1 compost has a specially balanced nutrient mix ideally matched to the needs of developing seedlings, young plants and newly rooted cuttings.



Storage:

Keep Levington John Innes compost away from pesticides, particularly lawn weed killers or fertiliser containing lawn weed killers. Use the compost within a year. Keep the compost bag closed when not being used to stop it drying out. Storing from one year to another may result in the fertiliser ratios becoming unbalanced.

XS	8L	1x	or	1x	 1 SMALL 25CM (10") POT, 1 HANGING BASKET
M	25L	3x or 1x	or	3x	 3 SMALL 25CM (10") POTS, 1 MEDIUM 32CM (13") POT, 3 HANGING BASKETS

How to Use:



Pricking Out Seedlings:

Loosely fill the new tray or pot with compost and level.

Use a dibber or small fork to loosen the compost beneath the seedling. Holding the seedling by a seed leaf, ease the seedling out of its compost keeping as much of the original compost sticking to the roots as possible.

Make a hole in the new compost and place the roots of the seedling in the hole.

Gently firm the compost around the plant, spacing out the seedlings evenly. Water gently with a fine rose to settle the compost around the roots.

Keep in a warm, shaded spot protected from frost.



Potting-on Rooted Cuttings:

Add a layer of compost to the bottom of new pots or tray cells. Position the rooted cutting into the pot and top up with fresh compost around the roots. Water gently and keep in a warm, shaded spot protected from frost.



Growing On:

This Levington John Innes No. 1. compost provides all of the necessary food for up to 6 weeks.

After that time, water with Miracle-Gro Water Soluble Plant Food, or re-pot into Levington John Innes No. 2.
