The following Levington John Innes composts are available:

Levington John Innes No. 1. for seedlings, young plants, cuttings and plug plants.

Levington John Innes No. 2. for general repotting.

Levington John Innes No. 3. for final repotting of mature plants.

Levington John Innes Seed, for seed sowing and rooting cuttings.

Levington John Innes Ericaceous, for lime hating plants such as Azalias, Heathers and Rhodedendrons.

John Innes composts were developed in the 1930s. They are based on a traditional mixture of loam, sand and peat. The free draining, open texture of

the Levington John Innes Seed compost coupled with a specially balanced nutrient level are ideal for maximum root growth of seedlings and rooting cuttings.



Storage:

Keep Levington John Innes Seed compost away from pesticides, particularly lawn weed killers or fertiliser containing lawn weed killers. Use the compost within a year. Keep the compost bag closed when not being used to stop it drying out. Storing from one year to another may result in the fertiliser ratios becoming unbalanced.

How to Use:

Seed Sowing:

Fill the seed tray or pot and firm gently to just below the rim. Water with a fine rose, then sow seeds thinly and evenly. Follow the recommendations on the seed packet for temperatures, covering the seed and for shading.

Keep in a warm place until seeds germinate.

Remove covering immediately, move into a lighter position and water as necessary. Be careful never to saturate the compost.

Root Cuttings:

Fill the pot and insert prepared cuttings, spaced so that the leaves do not touch. Gently firm the compost around the cuttings. Water in using a fine rose. To maintain humidity, fit a plastic bag over the cuttings. Do not cover hairy leaved plants such as geraniums and saintpaulia.

Keep in a warm, well-lit place, out of direct sunlight. Water again only when the compost dries out.



Growing On:

Feed with Miracle-Gro Water Soluble Plant Food after 6 weeks, but pot on into individual pots as soon as roots become well developed or leaves start to touch. Once developed, prick out seedlings and transplant rooted cuttings into Levington John Innes No.1. to grow on.
