

Gro Your Own vegetable & fruit giant planter

How to use



Place in a sunny frost-free position.



Shake bag to distribute contents evenly.



Cut out panels on the top of planter along indicated lines.



Plant to the same depth as the plants were grown in their pots.



Follow the other instructions for your crop in the table below.



Water thoroughly after planting.

Crop type	Plants per bag	When to plant	Start feeding when	When to harvest
Tomatoes/cucumbers - under glass	3	Feb - Jun	The first small fruits are seen	Jul - Sep
Tomatoes/cucumbers - outdoor	3	Late Apr - Jun	The first small fruits are seen	Jul - Sep
Peppers & aubergines	3	Late Apr - Jun	After 2 months	Jul - Sep
Courgettes & marrows	3	May - Jun	After 2 months	Jul - Oct
Lettuce, herbs & other salad leaves	12	Mar - Apr	After 2 months	Jul - Oct
Strawberry plants	9	Apr - Sep	After 2 months	Jun - Aug
Peas	9	Apr - Jul	After 2 months	Jul - Aug
Dwarf/runner beans	9	May - Jul	After 2 months	Jul - Oct
Broad beans	9	Feb - Mar	After 2 months	Jun - Aug

Useful tips

- Canes and support structures may be inserted into the planter for crops such as peas, beans and tomatoes. Be careful not to pierce the bottom of the bag!
- We recommend feeding your crops with Miracle-Gro Gro Your Own Vegetable & Fruit Concentrated Liquid Plant Food.
- After harvesting crops, dig the used compost into garden beds to improve soil structure.
- If there is danger of frost cover your bags with a fleece or newspaper until it passes.
