### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE ONLY AS A HOME GARDEN INSECTICIDE.

For use on ornamental garden plants and houseplants.

Maximum number of treatments: 4 per year.

READ ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE.

**WHEN TO USE** Spray from the first sign of insects or symptoms. If necessary repeat spray after 14 - 21 days. The best time to spray is early morning or early evening, avoiding bright sunlight.

Outdoors: Use from April until the end of September.

Indoors: Use all year round.

**WHERE TO USE** BugClear Ultra Gun! is ideal for flowers, roses and ornamental plants. For use indoor and outdoors. Always test by spraying a small number of plants to check for adverse effects before treating a large area. Young tender plants, such as those grown in greenhouses, may be more susceptible to damage especially if subjected to other stresses such as drought or very high temperatures.

**HOW TO USE** Shake well before use.

1. Press down firmly on top of trigger head immediately behind yellow nozzle to depress safety tab. At the same time, twist nozzle to 'SPRAY' position (1/4 turn either way).
2. Spray thoroughly, to wet upper and lower surfaces of leaves.
3. Turn nozzle to the 'OFF' position after use.
