



BugClear Ultra Gun! works in 2 ways.

- 1. ON CONTACT** - It kills bugs rapidly.
- 2. SYSTEMICALLY** - It is absorbed into the plant so that it kills difficult or hidden bugs as they feed (for example, scale insects on ornamental plants).

Pesticide resistance in glasshouse whitefly, some aphids and spider mites is widespread. Where resistant bugs are present, this product is unlikely to give control.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE AS A HOME GARDEN INSECTICIDE

For use on houseplant, ornamental garden plants and listed edible crops, see Where to Use table.

READ ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE

WHEN AND HOW TO USE

Spray from the first sign of insects or symptoms. If necessary repeat spray after 14 days for houseplants, ornamental garden plants and after 10 days for all other crops. **Outdoors:** Use from April until the end of September.

Indoors: Use all year round.

1. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE.
2. To open the spray, twist nozzle to spray position. 1/4 turn right for the wide spray.
3. Spray thoroughly, to wet upper and lower surface of leaves.
4. Turn nozzle to Stop position after use.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Protection during/in use
KEEP OFF SKIN. DO NOT BREATHE SPRAY.
WASH HANDS AND EXPOSED SKIN AFTER USE.

Environmental protection
