The best time to spray is early morning or evening, avoiding bright sunlight.

BugClear™ Ultra contains 5 g/l acetamiprid as a soluble concentrate formulation (SL).

WHEN AND HOW TO USE

Spray at the first appearance of insects/symptoms. If necessary repeat spray after 14 days for houseplants, ornamental garden plants and after 10 days for all other crops.

Outdoors: Use from April until the end of September.

Indoors: Use all year round.

1. Shake the bottle well.
2. Using the measure provided add the recommended dose (see where to use table) for each litre of water in a garden sprayer.
3. Mix thoroughly and use immediately.
4. Spray the product evenly to wet leaves, until just before run-off.

Wait for spray to dry before handling plants.

Pesticide resistance in glasshouse whitefly and some aphids is widespread. Where resistant bugs are present, this product is unlikely to give control.

Always test by spraying a small number of plants to check for adverse effects before treating a large area. Young tender plants may be more susceptible to damage.

Bugclear™ Ultra kills greenfly, blackfly, whitefly, and other aphids, scale insects and mealy bugs, and gives a useful level of control of thrips. It can be used both indoors and out to control bugs on houseplants, ornamental garden pests and listed edible crops.

Bugclear™ Ultra works in two ways to control common and tough bugs:

1. **ON CONTACT** - it kills pests rapidly when they come into contact with solution.
2. **SYSTEMICALLY** - It is absorbed into the plant so that it kills difficult or hidden bugs as they feed (for example, scale insects on ornamental plants).

Bugs that are hard to kill by contact are better killed with systemic sprays.
