Citrus fruit trees make delightful plants for the home and conservatory, because they are evergreen and are continuously producing highly scented flowers and decorative fruits.

Ordinary compost is too alkaline and ericaceous compost too acidic for them to thrive. Levington® Citrus Compost has a pH balance ideal for roots to establish and to ensure a long life full of flowers and fruit.

Essential ingredients

- **Reduced peat compost** provides organic matter to ensure that essential nutrients are available for the plant.
- **Composted bark** ensures good drainage.

This unique blend with perfect lime addition for pH balance makes Levington® Citrus Compost the ideal environment for establishment of strong roots, glossy green leaves and abundant flowers and fruit of:

- **Orange trees**
- **Grapefruit trees**
- **Lemon and Lime trees**
- **Bonsai trees**

Care of your plants

WATERING: In hard water areas use rainwater whenever possible to maintain the slightly acid conditions of the compost. Allow the surface to dry out between waterings, then water thoroughly but do not allow to stand in water.

FEEDING: Citrus trees actively grow all year round. In summer they produce new leaves and flowers and in Winter the fruits ripen. As a result of this activity they need to be fed year round.

From March to September feed every two weeks with a balanced feed such as Miracle-Gro® All Purpose Soluble Plant Food for bushy growth and to prevent fruit drop and leaf yellowing.



TEMPERATURE: During winter keep the plants in a cool, but frost-free place such as a cool conservatory; greenhouse or unheated room. Aim for a minimum temperature of 10°.

Greenhouses and conservatories will usually be too hot for citrus trees in Summer. Move them outside when all danger of frost has passed. Place in partial shade for the first 3 weeks to prevent leaf scorch. Spray the plants daily with plain water to keep them cool and encourage pollination of flowers.

How to use

Use the compost directly from the bag. Do not mix with other materials. Firm only lightly.

Potting

For a healthy plant, pot-on every two years into a pot one size larger.

1. Place Levington® Citrus Compost in the bottom of the pot and put the root ball on top of this layer.
2. Fill in around the edges with more compost ensuring the top feeder roots are covered with 2cm of fresh compost.
3. Water well and keep in the shade for a few weeks to allow new roots to grow.

Storage

Keep the bag closed in storage to prevent drying out. Store in a cool, dry, frost free place, away from sun. Storage from one year to another may affect performance.

Health and safety advice

Open bags carefully and reseal after use. Use in a well ventilated place and avoid breathing in dust. Always wear gloves when gardening and then wash your hands after use.
