

WHERE TO USE?

Use all around the garden

Our multi purpose compost with added John Innes is ideal for all your gardening uses. Perfect for all stages of plant life, including seed sowing. It has been specially developed, containing essential plant food for 8 weeks, to give your plants a great start.



We strongly recommend using Levington Ericaceous compost for acid loving plants like Azaleas, Rhododendrons or Heathers.

Containers



Ensure that the container has sufficient drainage holes. Then fill with compost. Add your chosen flowers and firm lightly, then water thoroughly.

Hanging Baskets



Line the basket if necessary and part fill it with compost. Insert plants through sides of the basket where possible to ensure a ball of colour. Fill the basket with compost and arrange plants on the top with trailing ones around the sides. After everything is planted, firm lightly and water thoroughly.

Seedlings



Fill the seed tray with compost and level off. Firm lightly and water. Sow seeds following the pack instructions. Cover the seed tray making sure the tray is out of direct sunlight.

Cuttings



Fill the pot with compost, take the cutting (according to the type of plant), water, cover and keep warm.

Beds and Borders



Water the plant thoroughly. Dig a hole twice the size of the root ball. Part fill the hole with a mixture of 50% soil and 50% compost. Ensure the plant is at the same level as in the original pot. Fill in firmly, then water. For best results we recommend using Levington Organic Blend Soil Conditioner.

HOW TO USE?

Instructions for use

Use straight from the bag, it's as easy as that. When filling or potting, firm lightly. Keep the compost moist and do not let it dry out. Do not leave plants standing in water.

Storage instructions

- Keep the bag closed when in storage to prevent drying out.
- Storage from one year to another may affect performance.
- Keep away from pesticides.
- Occasionally a white mould appears on the compost. This is not harmful to your plants and should disappear naturally.

Health and safety advice



- Use in a well ventilated place and avoid breathing in dust.
- Always wear gloves when gardening
- Wash hands after use.
- Store in a cool place, away from sun.
- Open bag carefully and reseal after use.
