INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

When to use Use from April to September on lawns that are actively growing. For best results following spraying, do not cut grass for at least one day after treatment. Avoid spraying in drought or frost. To avoid drift, do not spray in windy conditions.

DO NOT USE ON NEW-SOWN LAWNS FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS AFTER ESTABLISHMENT. Re-treatment may be necessary for well-established difficult to control weeds. Allow an interval of at least 6 weeks between treatments.

Maximum number of treatments: 2 per year.

Where to use FOR USE ON LAWNS, for the control of most common broad-leaved lawn weeds. Including the problem weeds such as Clover, Daisy, Dandelion, Plantain and Common Chickweed. This pack treats 250 m².

How to use SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. We recommend wearing waterproof gloves and gardening footwear. Use a clean sprayer or watering can fitted with a fine rose. Mix well before use. Loosen measure cap slightly, gently squeeze bottle until required volume is achieved. Apply Roundup Lawn Optima at rate of 50 ml in 5 ltrs of water to cover 25 m² covering vegetation evenly. Hold the sprayer approximately 50 cm away from the target weed and spray to lightly wet the weeds - avoid run-off. Wash hands after use. Wash equipment thoroughly after use.

Caution Avoid spray coming into contact with cultivated plants. The first 4 mowings of treated grass must be composted for 6 months before use as mulch. Scorching of grass can occur if product is over applied. Control may be reduced if rain falls within 24 hours of application.
