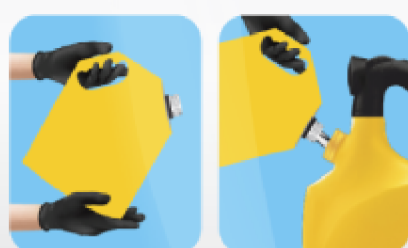

**HOW TO PREPARE**

This Refill pack is for use with the Scotts Lawn Builder Bindii, Clover & Broadleaf Weedkill & Prevent refillable bottle. If used in other applicators, the mix rate may lead to product not working as effectively or may cause damage to lawn.



**TO REFILL**

1. Find a level area, preferably outdoors on a benchtop away from food, animal feed and plants.
2. Check the amount of liquid already in the bottle. This can be viewed on the side panel. Aim to fill only to the full marker.
3. Remove the front bottle cap by pressing down & unscrewing in an anti-clockwise direction.
4. Unscrew the cap of the matching Lawn Builder Refill pouch.
5. Hold refill pouch as pictured.
6. Insert refill nozzle into the Bottle opening.
7. Carefully pour the refill product into the bottle. Securely close the bottle cap again.
8. Securely close Refill pouch and store or dispose of as per instructions.

**KILLS WEEDS**

DO NOT spray if weeds are wilted by dry or cold weather. DO NOT apply if shade temperatures are expected to exceed 30°C within a 72 hour period. DO NOT spray if rain is expected within 4 hours. DO NOT mow grass for 2 days after treatment.

**HOW TO USE**

**SITUATION** Lawns – established Buffalo (except ST varieties), Couch (including QLD Blue Couch), Bent, Fescue, Kikuyu, Paspalum and Ryegrass.

**WEEDS CONTROLLED** Bindii, Capeweed, Cat's ear, Clover (not TAS), Creeping buttercup, Cudweed, Dandelion, Fleabane, Jo-jo (onehunga), Oxalis, Plantain, Thistles.

**RATE** Apply entire contents: 2.8L treats 180m<sup>2</sup> 2.0L treats 130m<sup>2</sup>

**HOW TO APPLY** Measure lawn before application. Apply evenly over the area to be treated. Weeds die slowly; effects may take 3 weeks to appear. Repeat application may be required to control advanced weeds or certain types of clover. Slight browning of grasses may occur.

**PRECAUTIONS:** Before use on new varieties of buffalo, test on a small area first. DO NOT allow spray to contact or drift onto plants you do not want to kill. DO NOT apply within the dripline of shallow rooted trees or shrubs or apply the product in areas where the chemical may be washed into contact with roots of desirable plants. DO NOT allow entry (including pets) into treated area until spray has dried. DO NOT allow chemical containers or spray to get into the drains, sewers, streams or ponds. DO NOT feed grass clippings from treated areas to poultry or other animals or use to mulch plants.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store in the closed, original container in a cool, dry place out of the reach of children. Do not store in direct sunlight. Dispose of empty container by wrapping in paper, placing in plastic bag and putting in garbage.

**SAFETY DIRECTIONS:** Will irritate the eyes. Avoid contact with eyes. When opening the container and preparing spray wear safety glasses. If product in eyes, wash it out immediately with water. Wash hands after use.
