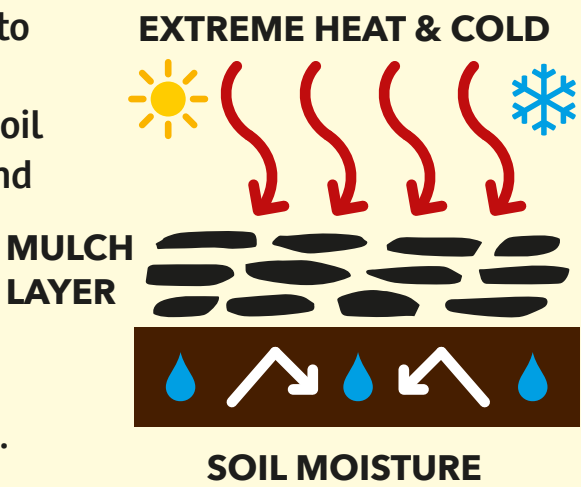


WHY USE BARK?

Our composted mulch has excellent moisture retaining properties, ideal for decorative purposes and low maintenance gardening. It is an entirely natural by-product of the UK timber industry.

Using mulch is an excellent way to reduce water loss in the garden. It reduces evaporation from the soil surface and keeps moisture around the plant roots, reducing the need for watering.

Composted mulch helps to improve soil structure when incorporated into the soil surface.



HOW TO USE

All around the garden.

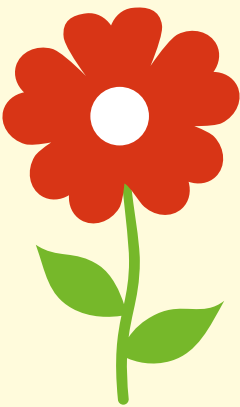
Composted mulch is perfect for a 'no dig' garden - it helps to suppress weeds, improve soil structure and enrich your soil quality. Use it in beds, borders, and anywhere around the garden that tired soil might need some improvement.

Our composted mulch is easy to lay on any surface and requires very little maintenance.



BEDS AND BORDERS

1. Remove all weeds from the bed or border.
2. Ensure the soil is moist around the plants, by watering if necessary, prior to application. This will help aid moisture retention around the plants.
3. Spread a layer of Levington® Composted Mulch at 2.5 cm (1") deep around plants.
4. For healthy and beautiful plants in your beds and borders, we recommend **Levington® Soil Conditioner** when planting, and adding a Levington® soil supplement such as **Levington® Chicken Manure** to enrich the soil.



POTS, CONTAINERS AND WINDOW BOXES

Creates a smart finish to your pots and containers.

1. Remove all weeds from the area.
2. Ensure the soil is moist around the plants, by watering if necessary, prior to application. This will help aid moisture retention around the plants.
3. Spread a layer at 2.5 cm (1") around the plants.



HEALTH, SAFETY & STORAGE ADVICE

- Use in a well ventilated place and avoid breathing in dust.
- Wash hands after use.
- Open bag carefully and reseal after use.
- Store in a cool place, away from direct sunlight.
- Sometimes you might see some white mould on your mulch. This is not harmful to your plants and will disappear naturally.
- Keep away from pesticides.

Enriches poor soil. By using composted mulch, you are adding organic matter to your soil, which adds nutrients and improves quality.

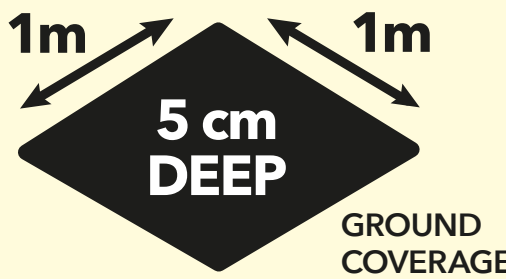
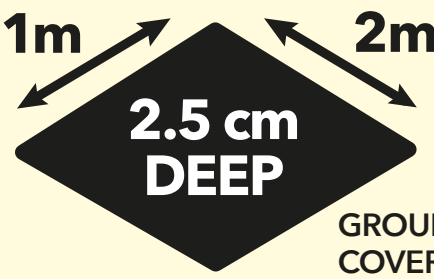


Composted mulch provides a lovely texture to encourage air flow and water retention, improving soil structure so plants can flourish.



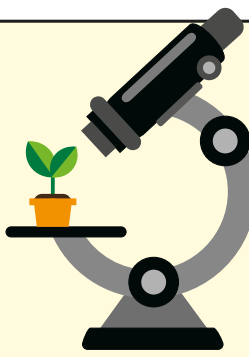
No dig gardening is perfect for reducing time spent on digging, weeding and watering. However, it's important to replace nutrients that are lost once an area is harvested.
