HOW TO USE

Our farmyard manure is made from specially selected natural material to provide a healthy, organic environment for all your plants. Use straight from the bag, it's as simple as that.



SOIL IMPROVEMENT

For general improvement, fork a 2.5 cm (1") layer of Levington® Farmyard Manure into the top 10 cm (4") of soil.



BEFORE SOWING/PLANTING

Fork in Levington® Farmyard Manure to the soil surface and to the bottom of planting holes, drills and trenches for an unbundant crop of flowers, fruit and vegetables.



VEG PLOTS AND ALLOTMENTS

In spring, spread a 5 cm - 8 cm (2" - 3") deep layer of Levington® Farmyard Manure over the soil and dig in before sowing or planting. On heavy clay soils, repeat when winter digging.



ESTABLISHED BEDS AND BORDERS

Spread a 5 cm - 8 cm (2" - 3") layer of Levington® Farmyard Manure beneath the branches of roses, shrubs, trees and bushes. Allow a 5 cm - 8 cm (2" - 3") gap around stems. This 100% organic mulch will help the soil retain moisture, suppress weeds and release food to surrounding plants.



PLANT INVIGORATION

In spring, spread a 5 cm - 8 cm (2" - 3") deep layer of Levington® Farmyard Manure onto the clean soil around established herbaceous flowers, shrubs, fruit and vegetables, and work into the soil surface. It will add nutrients for better yields and vital plant development.



NEW LAWNS

Spread a 5 cm - 8 cm (2" - 3") deep layer of Levington® Farmyard Manure onto clean soil and dig into the top 10 cm - 15 cm (4" - 6") of soil for improved grass seed germination and quicker establishment of turf.



USEFUL TIPS

- Not suitable for use in pots and containers, for which we recommend using **Levington® Peat Free Multi Purpose Compost.**
- If leaves start to pale this is a sign to start feeding, and we recommend using Miracle-Gro® Plant Food.
- Sometimes you might see some white mould on your compost.
 This is not harmful to your plants and will disappear naturally.

HEALTH, SAFETY & STORAGE ADVICE

- Use in a well ventilated place and avoid breathing in dust.
- Wash hands after use.
- Open bag carefully and reseal after use.
- Keep the bag closed when in storage to prevent drying out.



ALWAYS WEAR GLOVES

- Storage from one year to another may affect performance.
- Store in a cool place, away from direct sunlight.
- Keep away from pesticides.




